#### LETTER FROM REV. LAURIE GATES-WARD ABOUT GENERAL CONFERENCE DECISION

Dear Good Shepherd Family,

Today the General Conference of the United Methodist Church voted to remove language from our *Book of Discipline* that prohibits homosexual persons from being clergy or from being married by the clergy within our churches. This language that stated that "homosexuality is incompatible with Christian teaching" was first placed in our *Book of Discipline* in 1972 and additional language was added in following years.

Friends, we have witnessed decades of arguing and pain over the differences that have existed within our denomination regarding the role of LGBTQ persons within our church. There has been damage and pain throughout our beloved UMC. As a lifelong United Methodist of 56 years and as a United Methodist clergyperson of 28 years, I have felt that pain keenly and seen the damage it has caused to people of good faith on all sides of this debate. That included the departure of 25% of our United Methodist churches in the last 3 years through a temporary disaffiliation process that was permitted through December of 2023.

As your pastor, I am grateful that we are now being invited to enter a new day where all of God's children can be embraced and included. I am aware that while some of us celebrate others still have questions and concerns. But I ask two things of all of us at Good Shepherd. First, I ask that we each remember that as we talk about LGBTQ persons that we remember that they are first and foremost **persons** not an 'issue' to be discussed. We are called to remember the words of 1 John 4:7, "Beloved let us love one another because love is from God." In all that we do, we are called to offer the love of God in Jesus Christ to all of our siblings. I believe we do that in many ways already.

The second thing that I would ask is that we remember that in many ways we determine who Good Shepherd is as a congregation. Good Shepherd is known as a caring church that reaches out to our community and we can continue to be. As it has always been, discernment about who serves our church and who is offered the gift of holy matrimony within our walls is uniquely ours as pastor and church together. It is my intention as your pastor to engage in conversation with Staff Parish Relations and with our Leadership Team regarding how we will make those decisions together in ways that affirm our sacred life together.

For today, I give thanks for the work of holy conferencing that the delegates to General Conference are engaging in together. They are seeking the best for the spiritual, emotional, and financial health of our denomination. Over and over again in the last week I have heard the phrase "the local church is the foundation of the United Methodist Church." Decisions are being made to strengthen the local church by reducing financial burdens and increase resources for the work of ministry. We can truly celebrate that.

Please continue to pray for our General Conference as they finish their work this week. If you have questions about anything that you have heard, please feel free to ask me. I will be available after church in fellowship hall for a time to talk with anyone who might want to do so.







# CONFIRMATION CLASS FIELD TRIP OPEN TO ALL


